Which patients are appropriate to refer for this test?

- Patients who complain of hearing loss
- Patients who complain of dizziness
- Patients who complain of tinnitus
- Patients who complain of aural fullness
- Patients who complain of otalgia (ear pain)
- Patients who complain of otorrhea (discharge)
- Patients with a family history of hearing loss
- Patients who have been exposed to noise

What will this test tell me?

- The status of a patient's peripheral auditory nervous system, including the status of the middle ear.

What will this test help to diagnose?

- Multiple Sclerosis
- Acoustic Neuroma/Vestibular Schwannoma
- Meniere's Syndrome
- Serous Otitis Media
- Chronic Otitis Media
- Otosclerosis
- Eustachian tube dysfunction
- Perilymphatic fistula
- Sensorineural hearing loss
- Conductive hearing loss
- Unilateral hearing loss
- Noise induced hearing loss
